Tenor and Bass Drum Instructor JOB DESCRIPTION



SUMMARY OF PROJECT

The Strathmore Schools Pipe Band Committee is seeking an enthusiastic and skilled Tenor and Bass Drum Instructor to develop a high-performing pipe band within the Blairgowrie and District Community Schools area. This role involves delivering engaging and inclusive drumming lessons, facilitating band practices, and organizing performances. The instructor will be a key figure in the growth and success of the pipe band, supporting students from P5 to S6. The program is managed by the Strathmore Schools Pipe Band Committee, which is a constituted voluntary organization. The post-holder will report to the committee.

Lessons will take place in-person, at schools within the Blairgowrie and District area. Lessons will consist of groups of 3-7 pupils, from Primary 5 and up. The Tenor and Bass Drum instructor will be required to work a Tuesday afternoon, and help run the Tuesday evening pipe band practice, and attend competitions and events as required.

START DATE

The post-holder will be required to begin teaching by 21/10/24.

REMUNERATION

The position offers a competitive rate of £90 per half day, with additional compensation for travel expenses, as agreed upon with the committee. An additional payment is provided for leading the weekly pipe band practice sessions.

INSURANCE AND SAFEGUARDING

Tutors must hold Public Liability Insurance and will be required to hold a relevant PVG certificate, and to follow safeguarding procedures provided.

- Develop positive relations with teachers, and particularly the drumming/piping tutor to support learning, and the pipe band development.
- Maintain positive, collaborative relationships with pipe bands in the area.
- Report to the committee on a regular basis by agreement.
